# President's Message

It's hard to believe, but another racquetball season has come to an end. I would like to thank each and every URA member who took the time to help make a difference in this year's program. I have illustrated some of the major accomplishments of this year's board.

1. Utah now has a "State Championship Medal" for its state singles and doubles championship events. This medal will be something to look forward to, much like the coveted Olympic medal.

2. We now have a tournament sanctioning director --Rose Hernandez. Rose will collect all sanctioning fees prior to the event. This will allow the URA to work from an established budget rather than working hand to mouth and waiting on incoming funds.

3. I am proud to report to you that the tournament results are being submitted and all URA members are now getting their tournament ranking points. Please refer to the latest issue of *National Racquetball* and look at the large number of Utah players who now hold "Top 10" national rankings.

We all owe a great deal of thanks to Evin and Kathy Case for their outstanding job this past year. They are responsible for the tremendous effort and resulting increase in the URA's members' national rankings. 4. We were able to change the old practice of holding separate adult and junior regional championships. This practice was reviewed by the AARA at the request of the URA and found to be an excessive burden in time requirement and expense.

We now have combined the adult and junior regionals. This resulted in Utah sending approximately 20 juniors to this year's regional in Denver. A tremendous increase over the 3 that we sent to Denver the year before.

5. We were able to change the misconception that Utah was incapable of hosting a "national caliber event." Many thanks to Brent Cook and his staff at the Sports Mall for their outstanding support in helping Utah host a very successful Junior Olympic National Championship Tournament.

A very special thanks also to the local volunteers. Without your unselfish help and support, hosting this event would have been impossible.

In closing, please allow me to thank everyone again for helping make this a very successful and memorable year for Utah racquetball.
